

CODE 4 MAA INITIAL OUTREACH TIPS:

Did you refer a student, parent or family to any of the following services? If so, you can claim code 4 time.

Did you distribute initial outreach flyer to all students? If so, you can claim code 4 time.

CODE 6 MAA FACILITATING APPLICATION TIPS:

Did you help a student/family fill out the health families application? If so, you can claim code 6 time.

CODE 8 MAA ONGOING REFERRAL, MONITORING & COORDINATION TIPS:

Did you follow up with a student, parent or family that you referred to any of the following providers? If so, you can claim code 8 time.

Did you follow up with a provider (ie: doctor, counselor, CPS, Lassen works, dentist, school nurse, psychologist) regarding a student/family? If so, you can claim code 8 time.

Did you discuss a student's ongoing health concern with parent or medical provider? If so, you can claim code 8 time.

CODE 10 MAA TRANSPORTATION TIPS:

Did you arrange for transportation to a medical service provider? If so, you can claim code 10 time.

CODE 12 MAA TRANSLATION TIPS:

Did you arrange for or provide translation to a student/parent to help them understand the Medi-Cal/Health Families program? If so, you can claim code 12 time.

Did you arrange for a translator to inform parents about health concerns? If so, you can claim code 12 time.
